- #8 **2 ½ hours** of tutoring to at-risk homeless children
- #9 New books for a preschool classroom at the YWCA Child Enrichment Center
- #10 **1 month's** water bill so elder abuse victims can use the free laundry facility at the YWCA Shanklin Center
- #11 **3 hours** of personal advocacy/crisis counseling at the YWCA Sojourner's Shelter
- #12 **5** bags of toiletries/personal care items for homeless families
- #13 **1 month** of art supplies for a YWCA Child Enrichment Center classroom
- #14 **2 hours** of individual case management for domestic violence victims and their children
- #15 **A few** small appliances for a family moving out of a shelter and into transitional or permanent housing
- #16 **48** nutritious meals for homeless women/children at the YWCA Sojourner's Shelter
- #17 **1** whole new wardrobe for a homeless child at YWCA Past & Present
- #18 **1½ hours** of Batterers Intervention/Prevention classes for domestic violence offenders
- #19 **1 month** of cleaning products for the YWCA Sojourner's Shelter
