Woman of Achievement

A YWCA Charleston Woman of Achievement is an exceptional woman currently living in or native to the Kanawha Valley area, whose extraordinary work and contributions to the greater Kanawha Valley and society make her a role model for our young women and our community. This extraordinary woman's ethics and principles reflect the YWCA's mission of eliminating racism and empowering women.

Lifetime Achievement

A YWCA Charleston Lifetime Achievement honoree is a woman over age 65, whose contributions over the whole of a career rather than or in addition to single contributions embody the YWCA Mission of eliminating racism, empowering women and promoting peace, justice freedom and dignity for all. The person should be a role model who has contributed to the community in many ways, not just to one particular cause or solely through their work life.
